

NOTE TO SUBSCRIBERS

The primary reason you have not been receiving the letters over the past two months is because the internal mail server for my site is not working properly with the bulk mail lists since my site has been migrated due to a buyout. I'm not getting much help with it either, so I will migrate it again myself soon. I'll get there, though, and I appreciate your patience in the interim. In this age of buyouts and monopolization this sort of thing is becoming increasingly common, unfortunately. Regardless, in order to ensure that you keep having access to my letters, I have taken the step of setting up a subscriber page on this site, which will be private after I get this sorted, where you can access these letters for a one-year period. The letters are stored in both Word and PDF formats and will be rotated out on a yearly basis. The form of these letters you receive is not available to the casual visitor to my site. They are print-ready (without color or pictures) to save space, and they come out some days before being posted on the site. If you wish to see the version with pictures you can always come to the site, but that version is not ready usually until a few days after the original version comes out. Finally, I will still do my normal mailing, which will usually be about a week before the full moon, so if you think you may have missed a letter, you can follow the steps below to retrieve it. I will post a notice on my site when you enter either side (East or West, Dragon or Lion) so you will know it has been sent and uploaded to the Subscriber page. So, with these points in mind, here is how to access the letters.

Click on this link: http://malvinartley.com/subscriber_archives.htm (This page will not be accessible through the site in the future) Also, you can simply go to the Virgo letter (http://www.malvinartley.com/articles_west3.htm) and click on the button on the top tool bar marked 'Subscribers'. Once that is done, bookmark the archives page.

With these points in mind, you should never miss another letter. I appreciate your continued interest and support, some of you for many years now. I intend to keep going for many years into the future.
